

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TRANS ENOUGH? TRANS ENOUGH!

In Issue 37, we asked for submissions responding to Crok's article, *Trans Enough?* which brought up important tensions in our community:

I have been thinking about trans hate from other trans folks... What I learned is that Trans is a whole umbrella for types of people whose gender is different from what they were assigned at birth. No one is more trans, or not trans enough; we're just different. We have more in common than differences. There is so much gatekeeping and gender policing by the DOC... It is hurtful when we do to each other what the DOC and medical do to us. Why are we fighting over crumbs when we should join together and take the whole cake?

There's no one way to be trans, and we all get to define who we are on our own terms. For this issue, we're asking you to reflect on what makes you feel included, seen, and recognized as your gender. What is unique and special about your transness, your womanhood, your masculinity, or your undefinable self?

Ms. Tay | LT0387 | SCI-Greene: TRANS ENOUGH ??? WE ALL NEED TO STOP judging each other, and come join together as one. Being TRANS defines me, as my fem inner self, and wish no one WAS AGAINST me.

Eli Evans | PD3496 | SCI-Muncy: When I'm out in GP I have so many fellow inmates that call me Eli and use he/ him pronouns. I feel so much more confident in myself. But when I'm in the BMU / RHU things change. The other inmates say the cruelest things about my sexual orientation. Along with them saying I am just a wannabe transgender, which hurts inside because actually some of the inmates saying those things are masculine themselves.

I find myself very unique because of being transgender. I felt so lost when I was a kid and even in my teenage years. I just didn't feel right; like something was missing. Then in my early 20's I discovered that all along I was supposed to be a boy. Once I started looking like a man I started to feel like a man. I love being who I truly am no matter what others say or think. When I go back out to the community I want to reach out to others in the LGBTQ+ community and stand up for others that are being harassed and fight for rights as a person.

Lily Taylor | SCI- Coal TWP | QN9845: HHHeeeyyy!!! Guess what!?! I'm Trans enough.

What Makes my Trans womanhood unique is how I express it thru my clothes and personality. I'm a very laid back gothica/creative person. With some icing of stereotypical preppy blonde and redheaded fierceness. And if I were on the street right now, I would be wearing dark clothes, No matter what!!! Maybe dresses, though I don't wear heels. But I express my Trans Woman-ness mainly thru my personality.

I've been told that how I dress wasn't feminine enough, but there women's clothes that don't flaunt Femininity! And I've been told that I don't act like a female, but those who tell me that ain't around me often enough to see me. I slowly learned to be comfortable with who I am. So all I have left to say is fuck what the haters say! You know who you are! Flaunt it the way you think you should flaunt!

Timber/Taz/Tyler Trewitz: It is crazy that a lot of us had to come to prison to be our true self. We come from backgrounds that won't accept us for us, but we can be our true self in this place filled with haters. So I like how Crok put it. Trans is an umbrella of folks. I have known that I was gender fluid for a long time, but I never really found myself until prison, and I learned from HOAW that gender fluid is a part of the trans community.

During our trans group our Dr. told us of a person he met in CA that was gender fluid to the fullest. This person wore female clothes up top and male clothes on the bottom. Some days they would switch. That sounds like something I would do. Some days I am fem, other days male, and other days both. If that isn't unique I don't know what is.

Something that made me feel recognized was when I seen parole and the interviewer asked what pronouns I use. I wasn't expecting that type of respect.

Some people think because i'm not always comfortable letting Ms. Timber out that makes me less trans. Yes gender fluid can be confusing. Trust me I know, because it took me time to understand myself. That being said I answer to ALL pronouns, as long as they are used with respect, because I'm me and no one else can tell me how to identify.

Dayna | **SCI Albion:** Shout out to Crok for speaking up and speaking out on this subject. This has been on my mind for sometime. We are already bombarded with negative and hurtful words from those on the outside. But when we are faced with bullying and hate from our own, it cuts deeper. Instead of using our energy to put each other down, use that energy to uplift other members of the community. I celebrate my brothers & sisters' progress on their journeys of authenticity and I want to be supported on mine. After all, we are on the same team.

One man (you know who you are) makes me feel beautiful even when I struggle with self image. He makes me feel seen and helps me to recognize the woman in me.

Charli @ Greene: Divide & Conquer?

All these categories may serve to empower us, or divide us. Under the umbrella of trans there are many specific identities. On one hand, if we all identified as just trans, we would be erasing or ignoring many of our realities. On the other hand, our identifying with a particular sub-trans identity may cause tribalization. This may cause us to create the categories of us and them within the trans community. The in group will be important to us and the out group will become rivals, or worse, our enemies. However, this isn't inevitable. We must make a conscious effort to identify each person as a human being, not a label. If we become divided, the haters Will Conquer us. We are already an underdog, we can't risk weakening ourselves any further. We can turn this attempt to divide and conquer us into an opportunity to unite and strengthen us.

Samira, SCI Mahanoy: The thing that makes me feel included is when ppl sees me for being authentically me whether they like it or not and others come to me for advice on how I became this strong under the immense pressure that prison puts on the lgbtq+ community and not folding. I've been incarcerated for 17 years and to see how far the community has come gives me the comfort to help others and be seen as a genuine person.

What's unique about me is that I haven't tried to see myself better than others and I feel that everyone in the community is equal and that regardless of how I may feel on certain days I still put out the positive energy that we need to get through the trying days in prison. The other thing that's special about me is that I say what needs to be said at the appropriate time without ppl seeing the negative and then understanding what's right.

Tiffany Alissa Bradbury: When I reflect on what makes me feel included, seen, and recognized as my gender is the way I have the courage to stick up for people in the LGBTQ community that get picked on, on a constant basis, every day. The thing that I feel is unique and special about my transness is the fact that I have the quality to defend my sisters that get picked on. Also when younger transgender women look to me as a motherly figure as well as a role model.

Kaitlyn Mae Ayers: I am enough because I am the true me. People recognized me as I am because I tell people who I am and if they don't like me they don't speak. My friends and extended Family see me as a woman. Not this body which everyone calls names that irritate me but I shake that negativity off my shoulder and hold my head up high and smile.

Being Trans is already Unique. I have been wanting to become a Trans Woman since I was 7 years old. My Blood Family don't accept me for who I am but I just turned the other way to define myself as a Woman who NOBODY can tell me any different.

We have to stop Fighting amongst ourselves and protect each other. No One Believes In us or helps us to stand our ground in protecting our Family. And Non-binary is a part of being Trans. Because you identify as neither he or she, let no one say you're not TRANS. <u>DON'T Judge</u> anyone else because look in the mirror and see inside your Eyes and Judge that person looking back at you.

Everyone is Enough. Non-binaries: You're Enough because NO ONE can tell you who you can be, only you.

The DOC doesn't help us because they are afraid and ashamed to stare at People like us. Some are mean and ignorant and hate the trans Community because to them we're a stain to the human race, the lowest of the low. Even with Medical too some nurses are Super Nice and very friendly and respect you for who you are others not so much. I'm sorry but it's true.

The Black Pocahontae Yeshoni Chief Medicine Woman of the Blackfoot Nefari PHX: Believe it or not Da Black Pocahontae been Hearts' biggest fan for years now. I never made any submissions because sometimes it's better to listen than to talk. The issue of the uniqueness of my transness is something that I'm inspired to speak on.

I have a very special Heritage. I am Sioux-Lakota-Blackfoot Nefari, African-American-Indian. In our tribal beliefs if you had breasts up top and a D downlow you were considered not only very Holy, but actually a GOD! People forget that in many ancient cultures what society has tried to paint as evil was to our ancestors a symbol of honor and high status. So this is something I've aspired to. Take it from a real witch doctor and spiritual being: Identify yourself however you choose, but if you are under this Banner also identify yourself as a GOD! Because that's what we truly are!

To all those nervous about transitioning, I started my transition in 2020 at PHX and there was a few bad bitches here and when I started, they literally called me THE UGLY ONE!! Now four years later, I shut down every walkway at every movement and no shade all tea "Shoni" run this prison! Ask about me. So never let nobody stop you from choosing your best life. Remember you will become exactly what you envision you will be. Facts!

Whitney Ann Smith: so sometimes I question myself due to the stigma. Not just in prisons but in today's society. You hear the phobia of people saying "cut this off" or "just kill yourself." So here's my advice, you can take it or leave it. You got to be yourself, your true self or whatever makes you happy. I struggle with this due to the environment I'm in and the people I'm around. But even when I fall down, I pick myself back up and tell myself "I'm a strong independent woman. I'm a beautiful, wonderful person. I'm the person who judges myself, not anyone else." My other advice is don't let no man or anyone dictate who you talk to or anything you do. Yes everyone needs a special someone to help them. But you need to help yourself first. Honestly, I struggle with this too. But you got to be yourself. Girls, don't let anyone decide anything for you.

Ash Horan AKA Princess: First let me start with the definition of the word Transgender. 1. Identifying as or undergoing medical treatment to become a member of the opposite sex 2. Relating to transgender people. A trans person. Let's clear that up transgender is a big brush used to paint the picture. Simply by identifying as makes you trans.

Where the confusion comes in is every person has their own personal interpretation of what trans means to them. Who are we to exclude anyone. That makes us no better than those that exclude us. If any Brother or Sister needs ANYTHING, just let me know and I gots you. We need to be a family united and not divided.

Munta AKA Moon | JP4037 | SCI-Benner: It hurts my heart that this is even a subject that needs to be discussed amongst us. Aren't we marginalized enough? Are you not tired of being singled out? Discriminated against? Used as the punchline of a joke? Dehumanized? We all complain about how unjustly we've been treated yet turn right around and start persecuting our own. I've even done this at first until I got a better understanding of what "Trans" really is. I had to check myself. Now it's your turn.

I have yet to meet a queen that didn't persecute another for not being trans enough in some way. Couple examples: She's not trans enough because- She doesn't wear makeup- She doesn't shave her legs- She has facial hair showing - She's not on hormones - She couldn't get the GD diagnosis- She wasn't trans on the street - She waited until she's 30 to transition- She doesn't want surgery- She doesn't tuck - She wears too much makeup, she's trying too hard- She's bald- She likes getting her dick sucked and/or likes to be a top - She doesn't use she/her pronouns- She goes by a "male" name - She's gonna get the welfare pussy, real bitches pay for theirs- She wants fake titties, real girls are all natural- She's been on HRT for 20 years and doesn't have titties. There are so many ugly things said. HOW THE FUCK DARE YOU??!! We have it hard enough! Stop Spreading hate.


"Transgender" is a word made up of 2 words. Transition and gender. We Trans people are born with a gender that doesn't match who we are mentally, so we transition to one that fits. Being "Trans" is to alter your gender other than your gender assigned at birth. The "Trans" label is an umbrella that includes Nonbinary, Gender nonconforming, Genderfluid, and some Intersex, Lesbian and Gay people. The WPATH Standards of care defines treatments for trans people, "Changing gender roles" is one of them- How we act makes us trans. "Cross dressing" is another one- clothes and makeup make us trans. "Changing gender markers!" Do I have to go down the list or do you see my point? The people who come up with these treatments are mostly cis people. How can cis people show more understanding to our community than we show to one another? Let's tighten up. Schools out.

Personally, I went through/am going through several phases of expression. At first I went ALL out. Body/face shaves, makeup, pigtails, nails, skimpy clothes, everything had to be feminine. I did these things for myself to see how I felt. It fit so I kept on doing it. Then I evolved. I'm not cis female, so why do I want to be one? I made a decision to embrace being Trans. I let my facial hair grow for a couple days and wore makeup. My message is "Yeah, I got a male body AND I'm female. I look good and I'm rockin both because I'm Trans, this is ME!"

Full disclosure, I do plan on having full hair removal, HRT, top/bottom surgery, voice surgery and some facial work. It's gonna take years to complete, but until then, I'm a rock out with my cock out. I enjoy being able to switch gender roles and I'ma use it until I lose it. Even then, I'm still going to say I'm "Trans" before I say female. I'm forever going to be that extremely outspoken, sexual and visible Trans person. Can I get a "Hell Yeah?"

Anistasia Angel Narnor, Thee Queen & Lady She Wolf: Upon reflecting on what makes me feel & know I'm included, seen, & recognized as a transgender woman, I start by remembering how I felt & knew for decades that I used to have to hide my true identity except behind closed doors, at night. I took my own time & steps to start & continue to transition & progress - decided & committed fully to each & every thing & did not give up. Slow & cautious at first & for the longest, & then in the last year or more - rapidly & completely. I fully & aggressively resisted anyone & everyone who tried to insist & manipulate what they said I had to be & do or not do - they claimed makes a woman, wife, trans etc. i.e.- you gotta walk, talk & act all girlie girl, do this, do that, sit pretty & be a trophy etc - oh, If you have lesbian relationships & encounters, or use certain things in that, then that's not a woman-like, nor trans enough. I, on my own, make & mold my womanhood, transgender status, nobody, & nothing else does.

I got rid of most the decades old double life maleness & masculinity yet keep just enough bold & clear masculinity that lets everyone know I will rise up, stand strong, fight etc. I will not be weak nor anyone's victim & I will stand by the side of my sisters to do the same with & for them, especially if they can't or won't stand & fight for themselves for any reason. The haters in society & all around us constantly try to stipulate & criticize anything & everything & transgenders LGBTOI community & what makes womanhood & all else - sisters & brothers of our community must NOT fall into the same patterns. My Cherokee heritage, being a she wolf & spirit compliments etc. two solidifies my uniqueness, special, undefinable etc we she wolves are the rarest breed & style!



WE KEEP EACH OTHER SAFE

In Issue 35, we asked for submissions about strategies for protecting ourselves and others from transphobia and homophobia.

That conversation continues...

Maddie | **QP3525** | **SCI-Albion:** Question: When dealing w/a transphobic or homophobic CO, what are some strategies you've used to keep yourself + others safe? What would you say to other trans people facing harassment from CO's?

First, I'd like to take you back to 2015, when I was first incarcerated. Back then, I used my sexuality not as a flaunted tool, but as a comedic opportunity to make them laugh & smile. I never let people know whether I was gay/ bi/ gender neutral at first. I let them get to know me before I allow for those questions. Then I make them feel my position in life through my words. I tell them just because I am what I am doesn't change that I'm also your brother/ sister & I am human. What if your son or daughter came out as trans? Would you feel the same way? I like to lower their guard and humanize myself. If you're facing harassment from C.O.s, please take my advice. Go talk to him or her or them. Take a friend. Go up & strike a conversation. Then make fun of yourself & get them to laugh, lower their guard, then teach the uneducated on who you really are. Give the respect, even if it's not mature. Because we as a community, have wisdom & will teach those whom just don't understand yet.

SCENE REPORTS

Now that we are once again focused just on Pennsylvania, we are attempting to regularly feature reports on what is going on for queer and trans folks inside each of the PA facilities. Our hope is that reporting can be done collaboratively, where possible.

We'd love to hear whether (and how) Trans and Queer people in your facility are able to make connections and form networks/community. What can be done about it? What else should the community know about?

It took me a little time to make my mind up but after I told my siblings what I was about to do, they gave me positive feedback and love me even more. So now I can say I'm a trans woman. Even though I'm locked up things have been getting better. More men come to me thinking I'm just going to let them get some. I've come a long way in life and learned I won't settle for less. Know your worth!!! I'm the only queen on the block. I want to be around more so we can relate. I signed up for a group and I hope I get added. I'm down to make friends with anyone at SCI Fayette. I'm looking for advice. I have a question: My facial hair never stops growing. Are there blockers for that? I'm on estrogen, 8mg daily, and 300 mg of spironolactone. I never had a chance really to talk to someone about this.

I've been feeling a little down lately. Missing my family a lot. My dad reached out to my twin brother asking for me, I haven't seen him since 2014. I've changed a lot. He was aware of my life before we stopped talking, now I'm living a different lifestyle. Not sure if he is going to like or approve of it, but tbh I really don't care. I'm the one living this life. But he was always in and out my life growing up. I always wanted to have him in the picture, so I decided to reach out to him and boy oh boy did I explain to him how I felt about the past and what I expect from him now. Only thing is, now he is locked up as well. Not sure what jail yet. Hope my trans sisters is schooling him on what to expect.

H.O.A.W. Family,



I fear that we have fallen into a dangerous and toxic pattern of complacency, petty rivalries, gossip, and self centeredness. Aren't you all tired of the same old playbook... Meet a new girl then beef with her... like a guy then make eye contact with him, pass a secret note, have a few rendezvous, he tells you that "You the baddest in the D.O.C." "I wanna take you home" "You my first!" CAP CAP CAP! People leave, get transferred, and every dick goes limp eventually! So let's focus on something that matters. The job is not done just because we can buy Cheap Lipstick and Panties! We have so much more to fight for, like the ones before us did.

Where all the "Bad Bitches" and "Queens" and "Kings" at? Where are our Allies? It's our job to steer their focus, you know. We cannot just place all of our problems at the feet of outside organizations, while we squabble amongst ourselves. Challenge yourself, our allies and the administration on issues that matter to ALL of us! For instance: Why does the D.O.C. train inmates in some prisons in Cosmetology but none of them work in our Barber Shops? Nor do the Male Institutions offer the same services offered to Cis Women in Female Institutions. Why are we subjected to a lengthy/invasive Transgender Evaluation Process to determine Gender Dysphoria when it is not done for other Psychological disorders? Medications that have serious and permanent side effects are easily and regularly prescribed, and diagnosis of

those conditions are swift, with only one exception, Gender Dysphoria and a prescription for Estrogen/Testosterone! Why can't we buy everything that women in Muncy and Cambridge Springs can buy? Bitch I want to Knit too!!! (*_*) This might seem like basic stuff to you but... Nothing is safe. Progress can be rolled back by decades just with the stroke of a pen (i.e. Roe v. Wade). Always remember that the Equal Protection Clause requires the government (and its agencies) to treat similarly situated PEOPLE alike... see City of Cleburne v. Cleburne Living Center, 473 U.S. 432 (1985).



She can almost touch those tangible dreams.



PO Box 180198 Brooklyn, NY 11218 **Pennsylvania Institutional Law Project** provides assistance to incarcerated or institutionalized people in PA whose constitutional rights have been violated within the institution.

Mazzoni Center has legal services for LGBT people in Pennsylvania, including discrimination cases.

Pennsylvania Innocence Project only takes on direct appeal and PCRA cases from <u>factually innocent</u> individuals incarcerated in PA who have been wrongfully convicted.

The **ACLU** sometimes takes prison conditions cases, but they are selective in which cases they take because they do "impact litigation."

Impact litigation is strategic legal cases that have the potential to change the situation for other people in similar situations to the plaintiff.

Amistad Law Project takes on impact litigation aimed at reducing incarceration in Pennsylvania.

Abolitionist Law Center takes on impact litigation aimed at addressing human rights violations in Pennsylvania prisons.

Transgender Law Center is a national organization that takes on impact litigation related to trans rights.

Lambda Legal is a national organization that takes on impact litigation related to LGBT/HIV rights.

The **National Center for Lesbian Rights** is another national impact litigation firm that takes on impact litigation related to LGBT.

GLBTQ Legal Advocates & Defenders (GLAD) is a national organization that takes on impact litigation related to LGBT/HIV rights.

Transgender Legal Defense & Education Fund (TLDEF) is a national impact litigation firm that takes cases related to

Alyssa Rodriguez Center for Gender Justice (ARC) is a new organization connecting jailhouse lawyers and advocates working for gender justice. Members get *pro se* legal information and support for their advocacy.

trans discrimination.

BOOKS, PUBLICATIONS & PENPAL RESOURCES

Books Through Bars provides small packages of free books to individuals incarcerated. Ithaca College Books Thru Bars send free books nationwide. Pittsburgh Prison Book System sends free educational books and quality reading material to prisoners and prison libraries. Books For Prisoners at UCSD and East Bay Prisoner Support send socially conscious reading materials nationwide. Tranzmission Prison Project sends books and trans booklets to incarcerated LGBTQ folks nationwide. Prisoners Literature Project and Prison Library Project ship free books.

Send a letter that includes your name, ID number, full address, any restrictions on incoming books, and types of books wanted. Make your request by subject rather than specific title or author, and provide several areas of interest if possible. For example, African American history, basic math, carpentry, how to draw.

Please be patient. These programs get many requests, so it may take a while.

Black & Pink, and Montreal Prisoner Correspondence Project, are organizations that matches incarcerated members of the LGBT community anywhere in the country (and in Canada) with pen pals.

Let's Get Free has a magazine available to folks in PA prisons.

Hearts on a Wire appears on several resource lists as a pen pal organization. While we are aware how valuable it can be to have contact with people, this has *never* been a service we have provided, nor is it something we have the capacity to take on. Hearts has worked to correct these resource guides as we become aware of them, but we continue to get frequent requests for pen pal matching.
